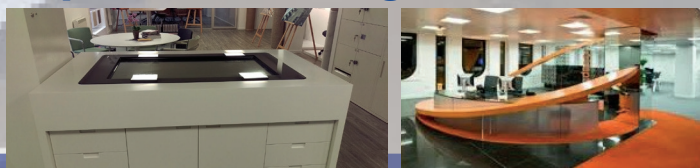

## MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING

HELD AT FELSTED SCHOOL FELSTED ESSEX CM6 3LL

THURSDAY 30<sup>th</sup> MAY 2019

The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master Terence D. Sheern, accompanied by Provincial Grand Officers entered Provincial Grand Lodge at 3.00 p.m.

The names of those attending are recorded on the Attendance Sheets, a total of sixty three Official guests, together with numerous Grand Officers, Provincial Grand Officers and Brethren of the Province.

The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master Opened Provincial Grand Lodge.

The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master was Saluted.

The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master welcomed Guests of the Province of Essex and all Brethren who were not members of the Province.

The Minutes of the Annual Meeting held on Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2018, having been circulated to the Brethren were confirmed.

Tribute was paid to the memory of Brethren of the Province of Essex who had passed to the Grand Lodge above since the last Annual Meeting. The Brethren Stood to Order while the Deputy Provincial Grand Master, V.W. Bro. Richard Bowyer read their names and Lodges. The Provincial Grand Chaplain then offered prayer and the Brethren sang "*The day Thou gavest, Lord, is ended.*"

The Provincial Grand Secretary reported apologies from Provincial Grand Masters of Provinces unable to be at Felsted and from Brethren of the Province.

The Provincial Grand Secretary confirmed that all Mark and Royal Ark Mariner Lodges of the Province were represented at this Provincial Meeting.

Acceptance of the Report of the Committee of General Purposes as printed in the Booklet was Proposed by W.Bro. J. Stannard, (Acting) Provincial Grand Master Overseer, the Report was Seconded by W. Bro. P. R. Hind, Provincial Grand Senior Overseer and was Carried.

Brethren as always I would now like to update you on other Provincial matters.

I am pleased to announce that this year's Northern Cluster meeting will take place at St Nicholas Lodge in Harwich on 19<sup>th</sup> September 2019. For those of you who have not been to that Masonic Centre, Harwich has its own unique aroma and is well worth a visit. Further details will follow nearer the time

Likewise, and as the result of your feedback to move the Officers Mess around the Province I can report this year's mess will be held on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> November at Kirby Cross, Frinton home of Naze Tower Lodge.

Our annual golf day takes place on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> July at Stock Brook Manor, if you would like to join us for golf or just the evening events please see the organiser W.Bro. Richard Goodwin or refer to the Provincial website.

The Provincial Bonus Ball scheme introduced last year continues to be successful and through your generosity has raised over £2,000.00 for the Welfare Fund.

Likewise the preloved regalia sales have raised in excess of £1,200.00 this year for the Provincial Welfare Fund. So don't forget you can buy regalia for most Orders straight from our website paying via PayPal or credit/debit card.

Some of you may remember last year W.Bro. Glen Remblance presented me with a very unexpected cheque for £2,000.00 raised by selling his Masonic coasters. Well Brethren Glen has done it again. This year raising an even larger amount of £3,500.00, thank you sincerely Glen. £5,500.00 in two years is a truly amazing contribution, thank you. This will be Glens last year for selling coasters as he feels they have run their course so if you are interested in buying some please be quick.

Your generosity allows us not only to continue supporting our local charities and Brethren but also enables me to make a further donation to our Craft 2022 Festival. Bro Provincial Grand Director of Ceremonies please conduct W.Bro. Rodney Bass to me.

Provincial Grand Master some weeks back I had the honour and privilege to be present at a Crowstone Lodge meeting to help them celebrate V.W.Bro. Ray Fretton's 40 years in Mark Masonry. At that meeting the Lodge presented me with a cheque for £2,500.00, which they specifically asked for it to be earmarked for the Craft 2022 Festival.

We have also added a further £1,000.00 from the Essex Mark Installed Masters Lodge and a further £9,500.00 from the Province. This allows me to make a donation to you today of a further £13,000.00. This as you know is our third donation towards the Craft 2022 Festival. This brings our total to date to £25,000.00.

The Mark Province is grateful for your support and that of your other senior members of the Province so it is only right we reciprocate that support not only to the Craft but also to the 2022 Festival.

Brethren as the result of the forthcoming changes recently announced by the Craft Provincial Grand Master and Grand Superintendent we in the Mark in Essex will be privileged to have 9 of the 10 Craft Executive and all Executive Members of the Holy Royal as Members of this Order. This is real support for the fourth regular step in Freemasonry so if you ever hear a Brother say Mark Masonry is not real Masonry you may like to point this out to them.

Our plans for further Lodges are progressing and we hope to consecrate two Mark Lodges this year, a Saturday morning breakfast Lodge which will meet at three different locations in the North of the Province, if you would like further details please contact W.Bro. John Stannard.

And a Military Lodge which will meet twice a year, if you have served in the Armed Forces and would be interested in joining then please contact W.Bros Bill Dyer or Ray McKerron.

Work is also under way to reinvigorate an existing unused warrant for a DC's Lodge, again any existing DC's ADC's or those who aspire to one of those Offices and who may be interested in joining please see W.Bros. John Finlay Provincial Director of Ceremonies or Mick West the Provincial Deputy Director of Ceremonies.

Last year I had the pleasure to introduce to you the father of our Province 97 year old W.Bro. Wally Stevens, sadly Brethren you heard earlier that Wally passed away this year, so today Brethren we have a new father of the Province, the oldest member of our Province is now a very young 96 year old W.Bro. Dick Caldwell. Welcome Dick thank you for attending.

Brethren as well as having the father of the Province here today we also have one of the most recent Members. Bro Tony Hicks who joined the Mark 2 weeks ago. We all welcome you into the Mark, thank you for your attendance today and we wish you many happy years amongst us.

Brethren as always I would like to give you a quick update on our membership numbers as the data in the meeting booklet is nearly a year out of date.

I can report that the Royal Ark Mariner Province of Essex remains the third largest Province in the constitution having increased our membership and member numbers further to a new record. With a gross increase of 4.3% to our membership and a 3.8% increase in our members since the end of year date published in the booklet.

This means our Royal Ark Mariner membership and member numbers in ratio to the Mark is now over 75%, which is an excellent achievement.

The Mark also continues to grow and we have a 4.3% gross increase in our membership and a 7.9% gross increase in our members since the same end of year date. This is excellent news and I thank you all for your continued efforts.

Brethren it was my pleasure to re appoint my Deputy and two Assistant Provincial Grand Masters as they work tirelessly behind the scenes on your behalf.

Having confirmed my intention to reappointment them, V.W.Bro. Tony Latham the gent that he is, suggested I should start looking for a younger member to take his place, he felt at 78 years of age he deserved a rest. And so after some long consideration I have decided to let Tony retire.

As you know Brethren it has been the custom in this Province to invest appoint and install new Deputy and Assistant Provincial Grand Masters at our Installed Masters Lodge meeting, this Lodge is a significant Lodge in our Province with nearly 270 members.

By taking this approach it also frees up time at this meeting and adds purpose to the Installed Masters Meeting. I can therefore announce it is my intention to invest appoint and install W. Bro John Finlay as Assistant Provincial Grand Master at the September Meeting of the Installed Masters Lodge.

This meeting will be open for all members of the Province to attend and not restricted to Past Masters only. I do hope and expect every Lodge to be represented. Further details will be issued nearer the time about that meeting and further changes I intend to make.

Brethren W.Bro. Derek Manister stands down today as the Provincial Treasurer after serving four years in that Office. He says he wants to spend more time playing golf.

During Derek's term in office he has helped me put into place new processes to monitor Lodge, Provincial and Charity accounts. He leaves them all in excellent shape ready for our new Provincial Treasurer. Derek thank you for your support assistance and expertise over the past 4 years.

W.Bro. Bob Todd also stands down as Provincial Tyler today and I would like to publicly thank him for his support, over the past four year's thank you Bob.

Brethren some of you may have noticed two QR Codes printed in the proceedings booklet, one black and the other red, these codes when scanned by your mobile phone take you directly to either the Provincial website or the Provincial Facebook page. By having these codes readily available I hope you will make more use of both these facilities. The Provincial Grand Secretary will be forwarding these codes to all Lodge Scribes and Secretaries and I ask you to consider including these on your Summons. My thanks go to W.Bro. Paul Thurgood for the idea.

Brethren Provincial Grand Lodge takes a tremendous amount of planning I would therefore like to express my thanks to the Provincial Secretariat and Ceremonial teams for the enormous amount of time and effort they have given to ensuring that our meeting today has run so smoothly.

I would also like to thank the Combined Stewards Lodge and other helpers for giving up their time to ensure all the Lodge furniture arrived, parking was organized, and the temple and festive board made ready. I do thank you all most sincerely.

I would also like to thank those Lodges who provided their Lodge Banners they make a perfect backdrop for our meeting.

I hope you have or will take the time to visit the displays set up for you today and would like to thank the Heads of the other Orders for supporting me in providing the displays and information for you to view.

W. Bro Peter Nason has once again set up his photo studio down the corridor and will be available to take group or individual photos for you. He will print these out and send to you for the small price of £5.00, this covers printing and posting costs with any excess being donated to the Welfare Fund.

This is your day Brethren; it's an occasion to celebrate Appointments and Promotions and also an occasion to celebrate our Order in general and to promote the fraternal friendship we all enjoy.

**TREASURER'S REPORT**

I have pleasure in presenting the Accounts for the Province for the year ended 31st August 2019.

The Provincial Grand Charity Steward has reported separately on the performance of both the Essex Mark Benevolent Fund and the Essex Mark Welfare Fund and I congratulate those who organised the Golf Day, which was again a great success and raised nearly £3,000.00.

Our sincere thanks also to all those who work tirelessly in running both the On-line Shop and the Bonus Ball Lottery, both of which had a very successful year raising significant amounts for the Welfare Fund.

A legacy of £1,000,00 received from the late John Edwards' Estate has been carried forward in a separate Legacy Reserve to be used for the purchase of items required to improve the Essex Mark Provincial Grand Lodge, as approved by the Provincial Executive.

The increase in expenditure on the 'Mark Awareness' campaign resulted in the successful recruitment of a significant number of new members during the year and was countered by a similar reduction in the website costs following the setting up of the new Provincial website.

In my opinion the Province remains in good standing financially, has sufficient funds to meet any contingencies that may arise, and no increase in Annual Dues is therefore required.

Finally, I would like to express my grateful thanks to my predecessor, Derek Manister, for his invaluable support and assistance during the handover period and my continuing thanks to the Provincial Grand Secretary and the Provincial Grand Charity Steward for their help and co-operation in enabling the efficient maintenance of the financial records.

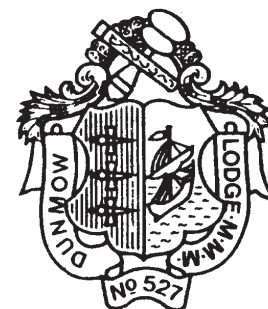
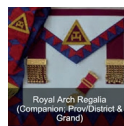
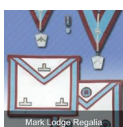
